- Food Vendor: \$85.00 + 10%
- Crafts: \$65.00
- Not-for-Profit: 10% Sales
- Commercial Vendor: \$75.00
- Ext. Cord Rental: \$25.00

If you are a **first time vendor, do not** send any funds until you receive your acceptance letter.

Vendors must be set up by 2 p.m. on Friday, October 11th. Festival hours are Friday, 5-9 p.m.; Saturday, 10 a.m. to 9 p.m., and Sunday, Noon to 5 p.m. **PumpkinFest** is held in Patee Park and on the grounds of the Pony Express National Museum, between 9th and 10th streets, in historical downtown St. Joseph.

Location of your booth will not be known until Friday, Oct. 11th when you arrive on the grounds. Due to printing and advertising, we will not be able to change your booth assignment. We request booths remain intact throughout the weekend until the festival ends. Due to possible inclement weather conditions, you need to be able to secure your booth and merchandise.

Jurying:

Vendors will be juried by the **PumpkinFest** committee for uniqueness, appropriateness, and variety. We insist on quality and professionalism, and we consider you a partner in our continued success.

Requirements:

Each applicant is required to submit color photo(s) of their booth or craft with the attached application. **(Photos will not be returned.)** You are responsible for calculating, collecting, and reporting your own sales tax. **Security will be provided on the grounds, however we cannot assume liability for your items. Bring your own 50' or 100' extension cords.**

Deadline: Applications must be turned in by August 1, 2019.

Space and Lighting:

Exhibit space is limited to 10' X 10'. Additional space must be requested on the application. **Electricity for lighting will be available. You must supply your own 50' foot heavy-duty outdoor extension cords.**
